### President's Corner

Those of you that have a Missouri Concealed Carry Endorsement I would like to remind you to check the expiration date. No reminders will be sent out so you are on your own to keep your endorsement valid. The advantage of maintaining your endorsement is many fold. Such as school zones and posted premises you will not be charged with a felony and all that occurs is you will be asked to leave. This endorsement also certifies that you are a good guy that has passed background checks and take responsibility seriously.

The St. Louis City requires you make an appointment for the renewal at 12th and Market St., 8th floor. The phone number is 314-613-7155. The time frame for renewal is the full month of your expiration date. The cost for renewal in St. Louis City is \$50.00 cash, check or credit card.

Sherif Vernon Betts has been a good supporter of Missouri Concealed Carry. He has been very helpful with acquiring the endorsement and when issues pop up he is right there to resolve any questions. A GCLA member went to get his Missouri CCW, he is a certified range instructor for the NRA. He met all the current requirements for Missouri Conceal Carry. The clerk was very uncooperative and was not well informed on the qualifications needed. GCLA contacted Sherif Vernon Betts and discussed the problem. Sherif Betts informed the clerk that the qualifications for the GCLA member applying were more than adequate. As a personal touch he gave his private phone number to the GCLA member to call upon his arrival. He personally saw that the application was processed in due form.

Sherif Vernon Betts has been primaried out this year. Vernon has been a friend to concealed Carry in St. Louis City and will be greatly missed.

GCLA highly recommends that you get your Missouri Concealed Carry Endorsement. Missouri has reciprocity agreements with many states that honor Missouri CCW. So if you travel to these states you are covered by the Missouri CCW card. The benefits are many fold. The effort is well spent.

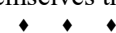

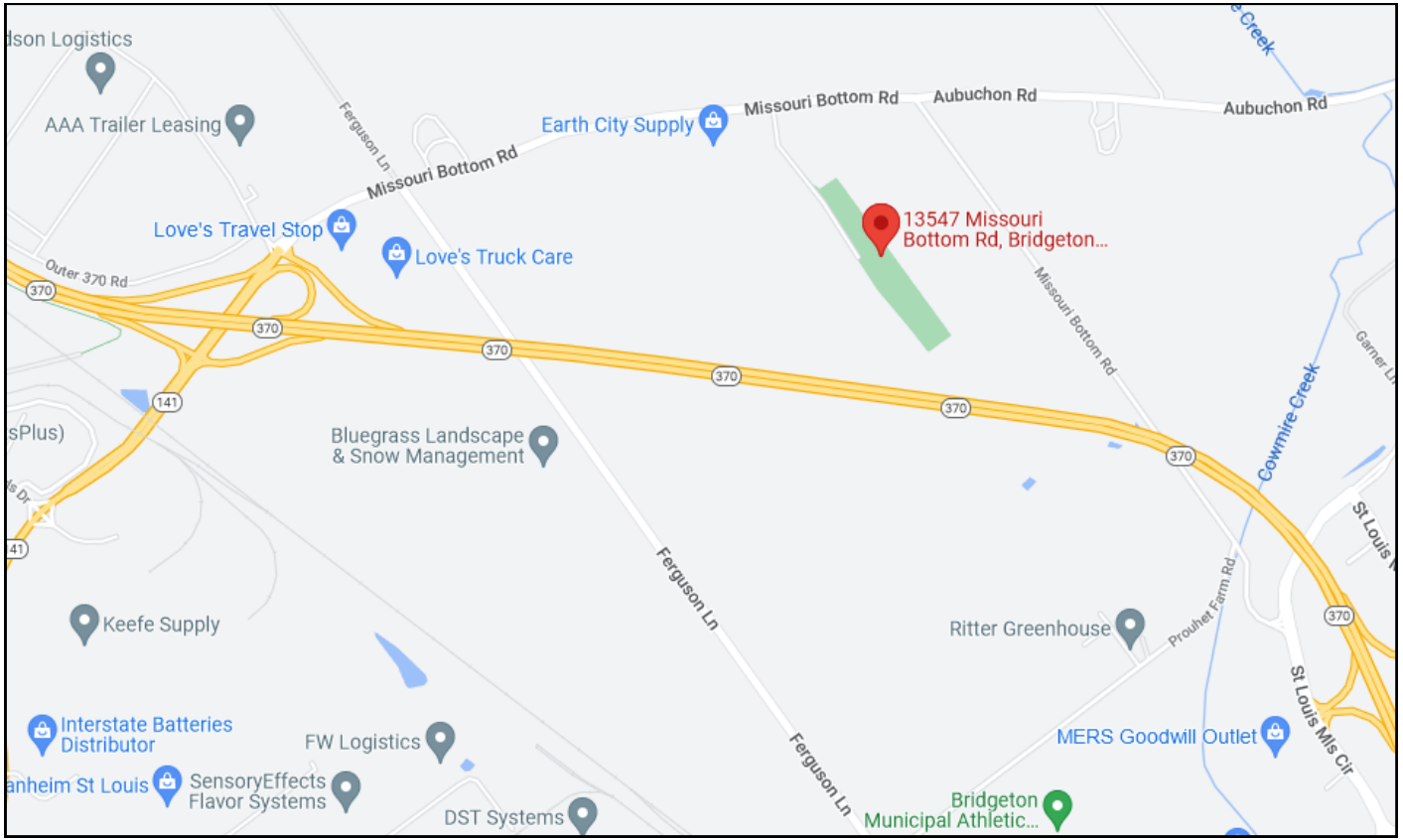
## GCLA-PAC

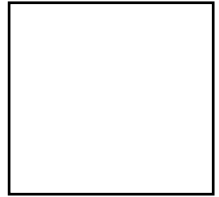
